









Globoscope

	<p>Globoscope is a touring artwork by French company, Collectif Coin.</p> <p>Find out more about their work: home Collectif Coin (collectif-coin.com)</p>
	<p>This is a free outdoor artwork.</p> <p>It is suitable for all ages including children.</p> <p>You do not need to book or have a ticket.</p>
	<p>You can walk around the piece or stay still and watch.</p>

	<p>The site may be busy and noisy.</p> <p>There will be event staff to keep you safe.</p>
	<p>The music plays on a 15 minute loop.</p> <p>The performance is durational. This means you can stay as long as you like.</p>
	<p>What is Globoscope?</p> <p>It is an outdoor artwork of over 200 lit-up balls across the area with beautiful music.</p> <p>These bright balls will be lit up and turned off.</p>
	<p>How do the lights work?</p> <p>Each ball is a light on an LED screen. The balls are programmed to create light patterns.</p>



Why did the artist make this piece?

Collectif Coin plays with the ideas of:

- Large-scale shows
- Intimate ideas
- Digital Art
- The connection of the body with sound and light
- Working in different spaces

This artwork uses the simple idea of the balls in a large space.

The artist hopes to transport your mind to a new dreamy world. Explore the patterns and digital patterns of the lights.
