


What to Expect

The protest movement began following the death of Mahsa Amini almost a year ago.




Brave young people are currently fighting for their Human Rights.

Show begins with the sounds of live singing and santoor.




The lead dancer responds to the music.

Others will join and sing an Iranian song, "Soltane Ghalbha."


This song has memories for many Iranian people.
